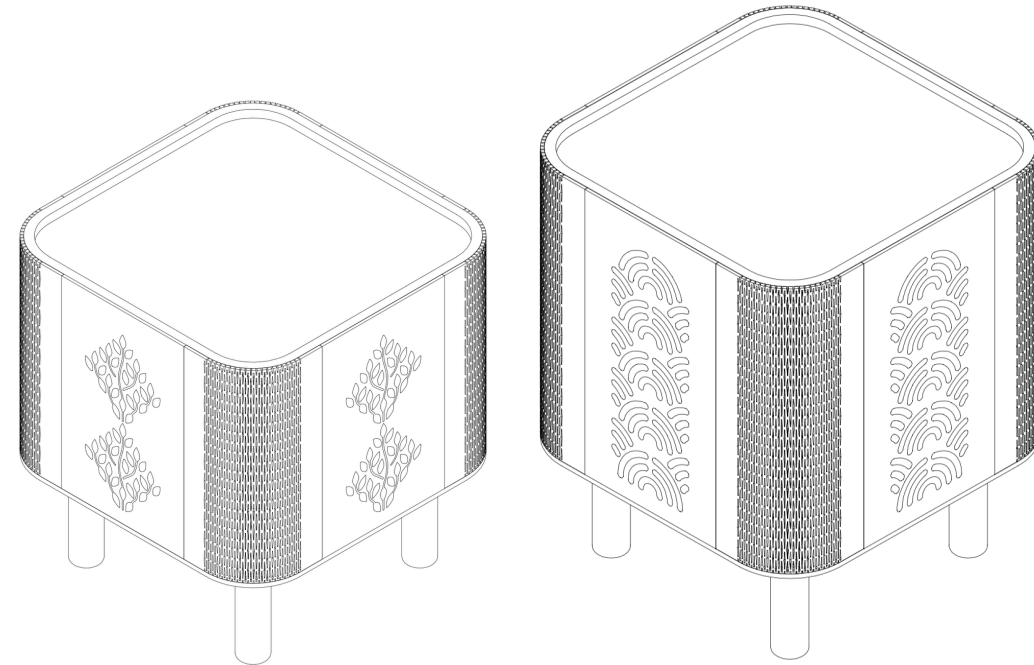

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Read all instructions before use.
- Use only with the supplied power cable.
- Keep away from water and very humid environments.
- Do not insert objects into the air inlet or outlet.
- Do not obstruct or cover the air inlets or outlet.
- Disconnect from power before cleaning or replacing filters.
- Do not use the purifier if the power cable is damaged.
- Children aged 8+ may use the appliance if supervised.
- Use only manufacturer-approved replacement filters.
- Indoor use only; do not use in heavy-dust environments.
- Do not place heavy items on the unit or allow children to climb on it.

- This product improves indoor air quality but is not a substitute for ventilation.

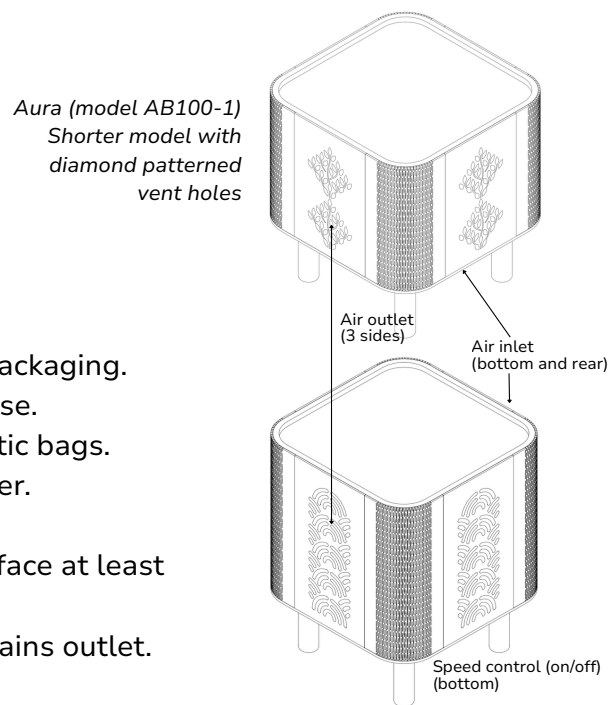

SET-UP

1. Remove the purifier from its packaging.
2. Open the filter cover at the base.
3. Remove filters from their plastic bags.
4. Insert filters in the correct order.
5. Close the filter cover securely.
6. Place the purifier on a flat surface at least 20 cm from walls or furniture.
7. Plug the power cable into a mains outlet.

OPERATION

- Press the power button to turn the purifier on or off.
- Select the desired fan speed or mode (if applicable).
- Ensure airflow is unobstructed during operation.



FILTER REPLACEMENT

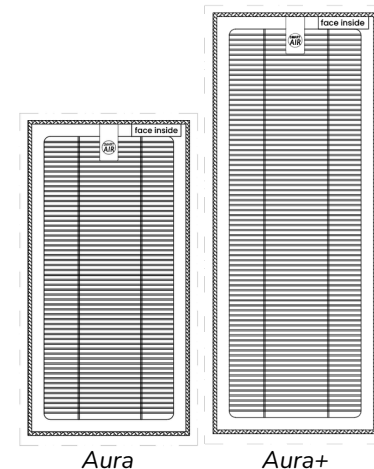
Replace filters every 6–12 months, depending on air quality and usage.

1. Turn off and unplug the purifier.
2. Open the filter cover at the base.
3. Pull out used filters using the tab.
4. Dispose with general waste.
5. Insert new filters in the correct direction.
6. Close the filter cover.

Use only genuine replacement filters.

CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

- Always unplug the purifier before cleaning.
- Wipe the exterior with a soft, dry cloth.
- If dust accumulates on the inlets, wipe gently.
- Do not wash HEPA/EPA filters.
- Do not use water or chemical cleaners on the purifier.
- Wood finish care (if applicable):
- Minor variations in the wood surface are normal.
- Wipe spills immediately.
- Avoid placing hot items directly on the surface.
- Wood finish care
 - Wipe spills immediately.

 - Do not use water or chemical cleaners.
 - Minor natural variations in the wood surface are normal.



DISPOSAL (WEEE)
